Early Literacy Seminar Wednesday, May 13th 4pm-5:30pm in Fellowship Hall. Anne Guthrie and Cheryl Clemens will present on early literacy, dyslexia, and the state of reading competency in Indiana. Both women have been trained in the Orton Gillingham Approach of teaching reading and have children effected (along with 20% of the population). Cheryl has been instrumental in getting legislation for the Science of Reading passed in Indiana, serves on the Scottish Rite Dyslexia Center in Indianapolis, and is a founding member of the Decoding Dyslexia group.
